Core Nutrition Programs: Addressing the critical window of opportunity from pregnancy through age five.



MULTIPLE MICRONUTRIENT SUPPLEMENTATION*: WOMEN

Over 1 billion women and children worldwide experience micronutrient deficiencies, a largely preventable threat to survival and lifelong health. Pregnant women are among those at greatest risk and more than one-third of pregnant women globally are affected by anemia, which is associated with an increased risk of adverse pregnancy outcomes for both mothers and babies. Yet, an affordable and highly effective intervention exists.



29% reduction in infant mortality, along with lower rates of preterm birth, low birth weight, small-for-gestational-age birth, and stillbirth



Every \$1 invested generates an estimated **\$37** in economic returns



Costs just **\$2-\$3** per pregnancy

Vitamin Angels will continue partnering with national and subnational governments to introduce, strengthen, and scale MMS programs. Guided by an implementation science approach, the organization will continue to provide country-tailored technical assistance that strengthens policies, service delivery, supply systems, financing, and monitoring to support high-quality, sustainable national programs.



VITAMIN A SUPPLEMENTATION: CHILDREN UP TO AGE 5

Up to half a million children become blind every year because of vitamin A deficiency, and half die within one year of losing their sight. Yet, vitamin A supplementation remains one of the most affordable and impactful child survival interventions available.



Reduces child mortality by up to **24%**



Prevents blindness and improves immune function



Approximately **\$1** for twice-yearly supplementation

Vitamin Angels will elevate its vitamin A program, coordinating program delivery with governments within an implementation science framework to ensure this powerful intervention is delivered effectively, sustainably, and at scale.



DEWORMING: CHILDREN UP TO AGE 5

Over 260 million preschool-age children are affected by intestinal parasites that impair nutrient absorption, contribute to poor health and development, and place children at greater risk of disease. Deworming is an effective, highly affordable intervention.



Improves nutrient uptake, which helps prevent infection, malnutrition, and stunting



Increases educational outcomes and economic productivity later in life



Costs just **\$0.50** per treatment

Vitamin Angels will continue to focus on delivering deworming alongside vitamin A supplementation, helping governments and partners strengthen delivery systems so children consistently receive these proven interventions as part of comprehensive child health services.

Vitamin Angels Will Continue at the Forefront: Advancing Implementation Science in Nutrition

Vitamin Angels uses implementation science, a rigorous scientific methodology, to implement proven nutrition interventions through effective, scalable programs that work within the context in which they are being delivered. Implementation science is central to how we create impact, and it helps bridge the gap between evidence and action by identifying what works and under what conditions. Working alongside governments, health workers, researchers, and community partners, we identify barriers to access and adherence, strengthen health systems, and generate evidence that improves program quality and performance.

Through our collaboration with the **Center for Human Nutrition at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health**, we advance the evidence base for maternal, infant, and young child nutrition. Together, we generate and apply findings that inform policy, improve program implementation, and help ensure proven nutrition interventions reach the women and children who need them most.

Vitamin Angels will continue working with governments and partners to layer complementary interventions where they improve program quality, efficiency, and health outcomes.

Transforming Lives Through Nutrition is a consortium of nonprofit organizations, including Helen Keller Intl, Vitamin Angels, and iDE, established to offer an impactful way to improve the nutrition of at-risk pregnant women, infants, and young children globally.

Funded by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, the consortium brings three like-minded organizations together to amplify their collective impact, reach more program participants more effectively, and tackle complex challenges more effectively than could be achieved individually.

Integrating Our Programming with Intersecting Issues Like Climate Change

Climate-Inspired Nutrition Through Action (CINTA) is a five-year initiative that will strengthen climate-resilient health systems and expand access to maternal and child nutrition across Indonesia. Funded by Takeda Pharmaceutical Company Limited through its Global CSR Program, Vitamin Angels will work in coordination with the Indonesian government to train nearly one million health workers and deliver climate-responsive nutrition solutions to 12 million women and children most vulnerable to malnutrition.

Meeting Countries Where They Are: Scaling Impact Through Three Pathways of Engagement



Every country has unique needs, priorities, and opportunities to improve maternal and child nutrition. In some contexts, expanding access to life-saving nutrition interventions remains the greatest need. In others, the opportunity lies in strengthening health systems, building local capacity, and supporting governments to deliver high-quality nutrition programs.

Rather than taking a one-size-fits-all approach, Vitamin Angels tailors its support through three pathways of engagement. These pathways represent different combinations of activities that allow Vitamin Angels to respond to each country's context, priorities, and opportunities. The approach allows Vitamin Angels to maintain broad global reach while investing more deeply in countries where long-term partnerships and systems strengthening can accelerate sustainable impact.

All three pathways of engagement are equally important to achieving Vitamin Angels' strategy. Together, they provide a flexible framework for partnering with governments and local organizations to expand access to life-saving nutrition interventions, while strengthening the systems that enable long-term, country-led impact.

ACROSS THESE THREE PATHWAYS, VITAMIN ANGELS WORKS IN 57 COUNTRIES, INCLUDING DELIVERING COUNTRY SYSTEMS STRENGTHENING IN 9 CORE COUNTRIES.



PRODUCT ACCESS

In some settings, expanding access to high-quality nutrition products represents the greatest opportunity to improve health outcomes. In this context, Vitamin Angels works with governments and program partners to increase product availability and provide technical assistance, supporting the systems needed for effective delivery.

Key activities include:

- Access to high-quality nutrition products
- Sustainable supply
- Partner training and capacity strengthening
- Monitoring, evaluation, and learning to support program quality



CAPACITY STRENGTHENING AND PRODUCT ACCESS

In addition to the activities included in Product Access, this pathway focuses on strengthening the delivery of nutrition interventions through existing health and community systems. In this context, Vitamin Angels works with governments and partners to improve the quality, consistency, and effectiveness of program implementation.

Additional activities include:

- Localized training and capacity strengthening for healthcare providers
- Nutrition counseling and community engagement
- Supportive supervision to strengthen service quality
- Integration of complementary nutrition interventions into routine service delivery



COUNTRY SYSTEMS STRENGTHENING, CAPACITY STRENGTHENING, AND PRODUCT ACCESS

In countries where there is an opportunity for deeper engagement, this pathway builds on Product Access and Capacity Strengthening to support long-term, country-led nutrition programs. Here, Vitamin Angels partners with governments across policy and regulation, health system delivery, supply systems, monitoring, and financing to support the introduction, scale, and long-term sustainability of proven nutrition interventions.

Additional activities include:

- Policy and regulatory support: advocacy, policy development, and implementation planning
- Health system delivery support: provider training, nutrition counseling, supportive supervision, and implementation support
- Supply systems support: supply assessments, procurement planning, and local manufacturing where appropriate
- Monitoring and information systems: routine monitoring, indicator integration, and data use
- Financing and transition planning: including cost analyses, budgeting, and sustainability planning

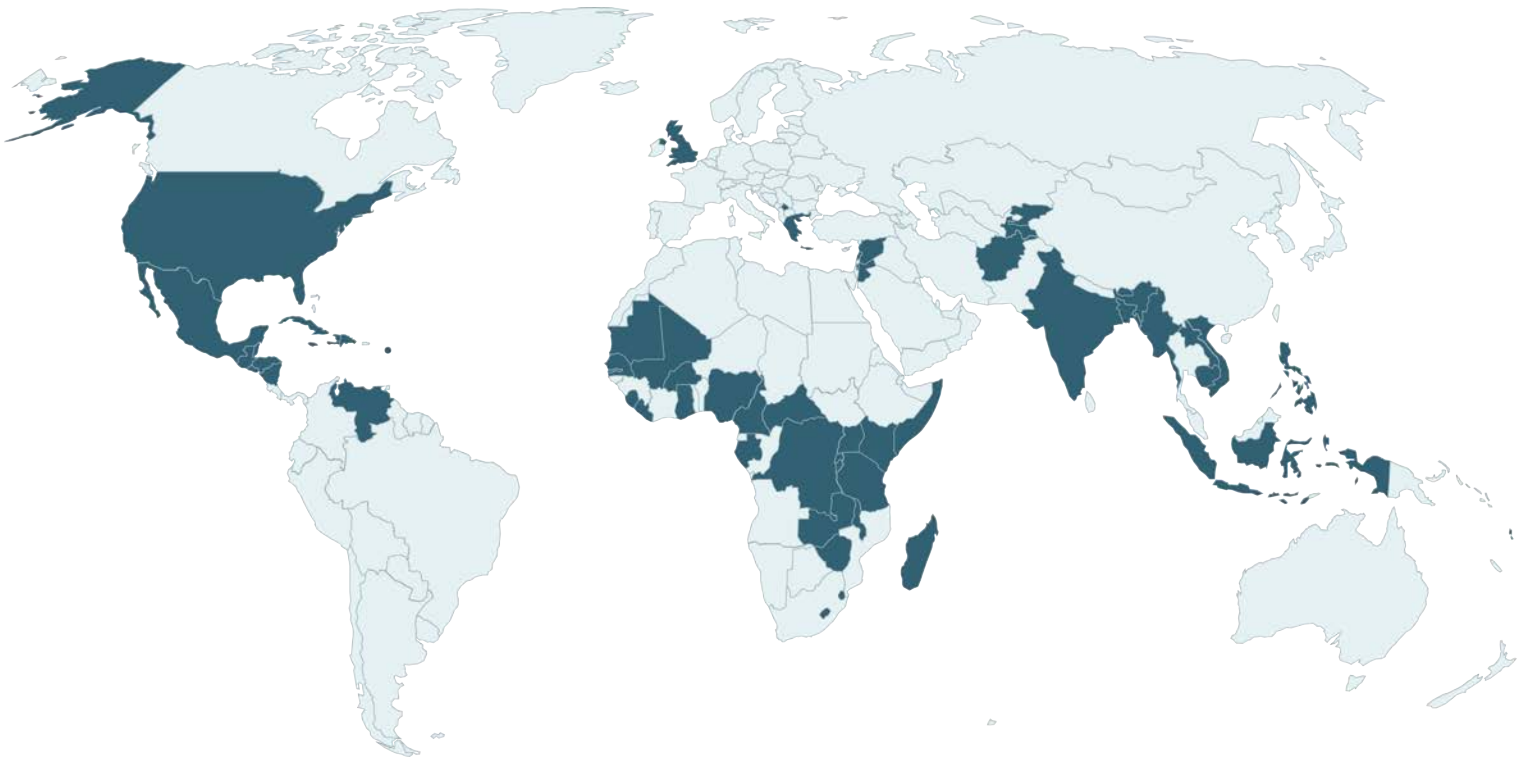
STRENGTHENING COLLABORATION WITH LOCAL PARTNERS

Vitamin Angels will prioritize high-impact, cost-effective, evidence-based nutrition solutions for women, infants, and children, and apply evidence, implementation learning, and innovation to introduce, strengthen, and scale nutrition programs across diverse contexts.



PROGRAM SYSTEMS AT SCALE
Vitamin Angels will focus its work on geographies where it can achieve the greatest and most sustainable impact. Its programs are advanced through long-term partnerships that enable government and local partner ownership. They are implemented within existing structures, and are adapted to local contexts.



SUSTAINABLE GROWTH
Vitamin Angels will invest in partnerships that fuel innovation, scalable impact, and sustained growth while strengthening its role as a thought leader and trusted partner in advancing maternal and child nutrition.



ENABLING SYSTEMS AT SCALE
Vitamin Angels will operate through a unified execution framework characterized by well-defined decision rights, governance, and accountability and supported by clear organizational priorities, objectives, and expected results.



ONE TEAM
Vitamin Angels' workforce will operate as one team across regions, guided by its **Five Guiding Behaviors**, which create a high-performing culture that engages and retains diverse and outstanding talent across the organization.

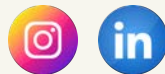
